WHAT IS PIT-TRACK?

The Pit-Track NPC (non-profit) K9 Conservation and Anti-Poaching Unit is on the frontline of this war against extinction. Our mandate is the preservation and protection of water, flora, and fauna with prioritization of endangered species. Our organization deploys expertly trained and heavily armed K9 details made up of passionate professionals on direct protection of endangered animals. We are currently in operation and have details deployed in dedicated areas in South Africa on priority protection anti-poaching sites.

Together with our affiliates, we currently look after approximately 30% of our planet's rhinos, as well as vast numbers of elephants, lions, leopards, and many other populations of endangered animals. We protect the biggest rhino orphanages in the world to preserve clean genetics for future reintroduction programs and protect many wild meta-populations in key areas. We specialize in K9 Conservation and Anti-Poaching and use K9s for protection, apprehension, human and tracking, and for detection of contraband, firearms, ammunition, and wildlife products. Through collaboration with specialized Organizations we are instrumental in the development and research into future methods of preventing the ongoing threat to our endangered species.

Our impact on this poaching crisis, the brutal slaughter of our natural heritage and these creations of God, does not stop with our field work. We are closely involved with all relevant authorities, who acquire our specialties and services, and we currently operate in significant sting operations and investigations into corruption, poaching syndicates, and terrorists. Our sole ambition is to unite the animal lovers of this world together, to stand up for our wildlife, so future generations can also enjoy what we have and so we can all share this planet and its spaces, as it was intended, as one with our wildlife.

WHAT ARE THE CURRENT STATISTICS ON OUR ENDANGERED SPECIES AND HOW CRITICAL IS THE SITUATION?

ELEPHANTS

Our iconic African Elephants remain to date the most poached animal on planet earth. We lose one elephant every fifteen minutes, 96 elephants per day, accumulating to a sickening 35,000 elephants a year. These animals are being slaughtered for their tusks that are used for ivory products.

RHINOS

- Western African Black Rhino declared extinct in 2011
- Northern African White Rhino left with 2 sterile females
- Southern Black Rhino less than 3,500
- Southern White Rhino less than 13,000
- Asian One Horn Rhino estimated population of 1,300 individuals
- Indonesian Sumatran Rhino less than 100 individuals
- Indonesian Javan Rhino less than 40 individuals

Rhinos have been roaming this planet for 40 million years. At the turn of the 20th century, we had 500,000 rhinos and today we have less than 18,000 left on our planet. These animals are being slaughtered for their horns, which are used as a symbol of wealth, medicinally in traditional practices and for traditional artefacts and ceremonies and are currently one of the most expensive commodities on planet earth, driving its entire species to extinction. We lose between six and eight rhinos a day to poaching globally. 90% of the planet's rhinos are here in South Africa.

LIONS

- There are less than 14,000 wild lions left on the planet. Out of this population, we have less than 2,500 male lions, with the majority targeted by poachers and trophy hunters.
- Lions are being exploited and driven to extinction through the lion bone trade, canned hunting, trophy hunting, poaching, human/wildlife conflict issues and loss of natural habitat.

Lions were once abundant all over Africa. In the last 50 years, we have seen the populations dwindle from 500,000 to less than 20,000 today, which is 96% of the world's wild lions gone.

LEOPARDS

Leopards are the most diverse predators on planet earth, as they can quickly adapt to surroundings and available prey species. Unfortunately, this has led to immense human/wildlife conflict issues. Leopards have been poached for centuries for their beautiful skins, and in the last 50 years, the population has dropped from 750,000 to less than 75,000, with only 10% of the population remaining.

CONCLUSION

In the last 50 years, we have lost 60% of the planet's wildlife. Every living creature on this planet is under huge threat. The majority of what's left is already on the brink of extinction. The time to act is now. This is the responsibility of the dominating species on the planet as the cause of all of these problems - human beings - and only we can repair the damages we have caused.
